## THE "ELOUERA."

The writer desires to place on record the earliest discoveries of this interesting implement. The late Mr. D. F. Cooksey found the first at Mayfield, Newcastle, during June, 1925. It was one of many from this source, and figured in the Records of the Australian Museum, XVI. No. 5, pl. XXIV., figs. 2 and 2A, May, 1928. In December, 1925, another example was found by the writer in a midden at Lane Cove. This was described with the Mayfield specimen. About this time several were discovered at Garie, National Park, by a party of geographical students from the University of Sydney .-W.W.T.
