Sir

I have the honor to inform you for the information of His Excellency The Governor in reply to your letter of yesterdays date that I shall be happy to take on freight by the Frederick One Hundred Tons of Coals on the terms proposed.

I beg leave at the same time to state that previous to the receipt of your letter fifty four Tons of Coals were shipped on board her which together with the quantity specified above will complete the number of Tons required by Governments. I should therefore be glad to transfer them at the same price as charged by this Government to the Government in India should this much meet with His Excellency's approbation.
