Sir

In part remuneration for the service rendered by the Brig Nautilus in the weighing up the Elizabeth Henrietta on the late occasion at Newcastle, whither this Vessel was dispatched to render her relief, and from whence she also brought a Cargo of Coals for this Government, it was stipulated that Capn. Edwards should receive a Cargo of Coals equal to that which the quantity brought hither, or if she could receive to the extent of one hundred Tons that He should be entitled to that quantity either to convey to India or to dispose of them elsewhere as he should find most conducive to His Interest.

Capn. Edwards having now expressed a desire to obtain the coals I have it in command to request that you will order the Nautilus to be laden as soon as possible after her arrival with you so that her Voyage may suffer as little obstruction as can be avoided – You will please to take Capn. Edwards' Receipt in full on delivery of the coals to him
