23rd October 1816

Sir,

On the 21st & 22nd Inst. I have been favored(sic) with your Letters per the Elizabeth Henrietta, & the Lady Nelson each containing the papers Respectively Referred to in it. At present I am only enabled to inform You that a Number of Steel Mills(?) have been ordered to be made with a view in the first instance to supply the Demand at Newcastle and the spades and shovels will be forwarded as soon as they can be obtained – Another time I shall Reply more particularly to Your Letter per the Lady Nelson – The Elizabeth Henrietta is now dispatched for a full cargo of Coals, and Carries Reinforcements of Eleven Male Convicts who are to be employed in the usual way – The Accompanying list from this Jailor(sic) will inform You of the necessary particulars in regard to their names Sentences &c
