Sir,

As I have agreed with Mr Dept. Commisary [] to deliver at the Settlement of Newcastle on account of His Majesty’s Government Two thousand Bushels of Colonial Wheat and a quantity of Salt(?) Provisions(?), I have to request a license for loading the Brig Hawies back with Coal, on my owne(sic) private account which I did not conceive the Port Regulations required until I understood from Mr Nichols Master Attendant that my previous offer for Loading on account of Government at a freight of fifteen shillings per Ton on delivery was declined by His Honor the Lieutenant Governor.
