Sir,

I have the honor to enclose a Return
of Men who have absconded from their
Place, they are a part of that Party that
were released from the Gaol Gang on
Captain Wilson's leaving Newcastle, and
I greatly fear that many others will
endeavour to make their escape, as
there are many of the most notorious
characters amongst them.

I am in great hope that they
will be brought back by one of the
Parties I sent after them / There in number
one of which I left following the Toward
of Time, and as they have Parties with

them, and were only two hours
than the fugitives, I entertain no doubt
that this party will overtake them.

I beg you will assure His Excellency
the Governor that, as a portion on my
part shall be wanting to recover them
or to prevent the escape of others.
