Nobbys Road, Newcastle

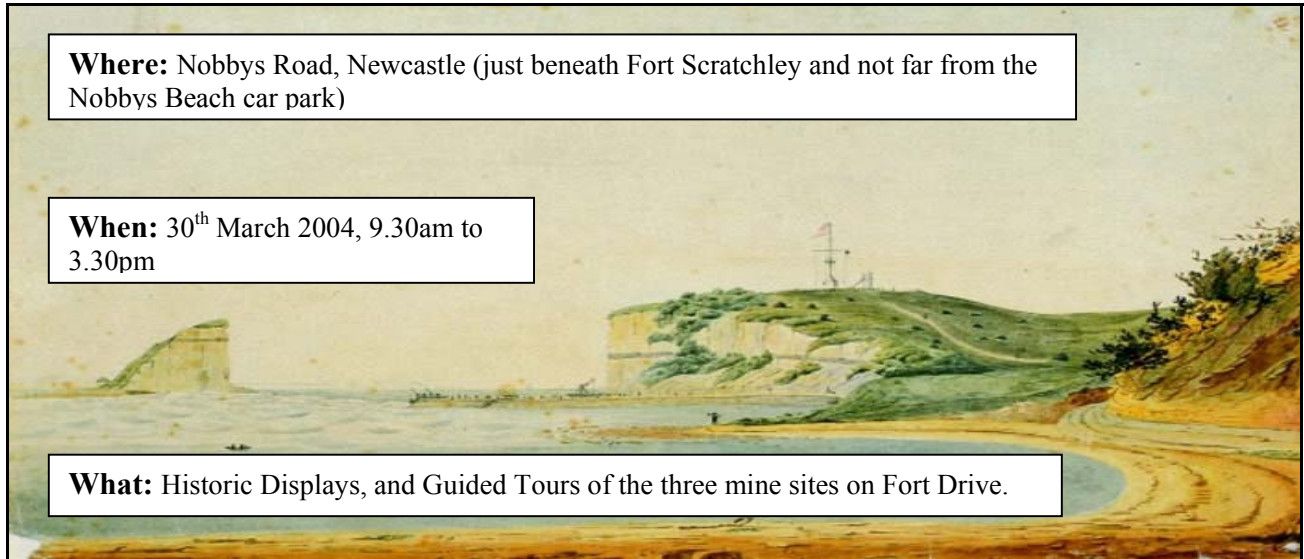
On this historic day, exactly 200 years since permanent European settlement, explore aspects of our convict and colonial history
