Mr. C. C. Humphries, of Lambton-road, Waratah, has forwarded to the Newcastle Council an aboriginal axe. In a letter to the council, read at the meeting last night, he stated that it would appear that there were only three of those "rusted" axes known to have been found in the immediate Newcastle district, although a large number of chipped axes had been found. This was evidently held with the lettering away from the palm. It would be noted how well the bottom fitted the hand. The axe was found at Mayfield in 1921." Alderman O'Neill moved that it be referred to the Metal Board. (Laughter.) Alderman Light: "An axe, Mr. Mayor? Is that not what we want in the council?" (Laughter.) The letter was received, and it was decided to thank Mr. Humphries.
