Plot Summary	Scientist John Hammond (Richard Attenborough) clones dinosaurs from fossilized DNA and sets up a dinosaur theme park, but despite the most elaborate safeguards the creatures still manage to get out of control. The concern that arrogant scientific meddling may set off events we cannot control, reappears in the idea that genetic tampering in natural processes that have taken millions of years to evolve may have incalculable consequences e.g. dangerous organisms, plant and animal, may escape into the environment to cause havoc.
