<b>Plot Summary</b>	Examines the political activism of the religious New Right, focusing on their anti-abortion activities. Interviews with fundamentalist religious leaders and their political counterparts are combined with scenes filmed at anti-abortion conventions and strategy sessions, as well as at picket lines and demonstrations designed to harass doctors, abortion counselors and women patients. The traumatization of women seeking help, demonstrations with dead fetuses, and bombings of abortion clinics provide evidence of the extremism of some New Right activists. Their religious intolerance and professed moral superiority extends beyond issues of reproductive freedom to a long-range political agenda.
